Up to \$15,000 in Scholarship Assistance

- Approved travel expenses
- Professional development opportunities

Eligibility

Applicants must:

- Be the surviving spouse or adult child (18+) of a deceased active-duty U.S. military service member
- Provide documentation verifying Gold Star Family status
- Complete required program application materials
- Meet scholarship program requirements and educational milestones

Scholarship recipients will participate in a structured educational pathway designed to support long-term success in commercial real estate.
